Tanya Peterson, Executive Director & President, SFZS.

#### 6. **Update on Primate Care at SFZ**

(Discussion)

Kathy Edwards, AC Primates, SFZS

Ms. Edwards presented an overview of the care and handling of primates at the San Francisco Zoo. She discussed the older group of three chimpanzees have lived at the Zoo for many years. Plans to build a new facility is progressing but will take time to complete. Meanwhile, improvements in the care of the chimpanzees continue. Chimp Care Components include: (1) Enrichment consisting of large item rotation as well as a wide variety of other items listed in the daily calendar; (2) Feeding of healthy items, variety in food preparation, presentation and timing with 5 – 8 feeding per day; (3) Habitat use includes access to indoor quarters and off exhibit yard and overnight access (weather permitting); (4) Training/Relationships with participation in their own medical care which is made possible by relationships with primate staff, and behavior observations and frequent keeper interactions; (5) Chimpanzee Husbandry Workshop in June attended by two keepers which consisted of five days of chimpanzee discussions with chimp experts. Also, she noted improvements have been made to the habitat included installation of a transfer crate for training; an ultrasound panel for geriatric male echocardiograms; and, in progress is the expansion of two indoor rooms into one large play room.
