Agenda Item Wording: Discussion and possible action to recommend to the Board of Supervisors to accept and expend a gift-in-place valued at \$54,000 from the Visitacion Valley Greenway Project, a community organization, to enhance the Visitacion Valley Greenway Agriculture Lot

Background:

The Visitacion Valley Agriculture lot, located at the northwest corner of Campbell/Rutland Streets, is one of the parcels that comprise the Visitacion Valley Greenway. The Visitacion Valley Greenway Project, a community-based advocacy group, is proposing to install decomposed granite on walkways; build new fencing, a new trellis and new redwood plot dividers; and provide some concrete work at the Visitacion Valley Greenway Agriculture Lot as a gift-in-place to the City.

The gift-in-place is valued at \$54,000. Gifts to the City valued at over \$10,000 require the approval by the Board of Supervisors.

9 WHEREAS, Visitacion Valley Greenway Project ("VVGP") is a
10 community-based advocacy group for the Visitacion Valley
11 neighborhood, including the Greenway Agricultural Lot; and,

12 WHEREAS, The VVGP is proposing to install decomposed granite on
13 walkways; build new fencing, a new trellis, and new redwood plot
14 dividers; and provide some concrete work as a gift-in-place to the
15 City; and,

16 WHEREAS, The gift-in-place includes the labor, materials and all
17 appurtenances required to provide improvements at the Visitacion
18 Valley Greenway Agricultural Lot; and,

19 WHEREAS, The improvement work will be completed to the standards
20 established by the Recreation and Park Department; and

21 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission recommends to the
22 Board of Supervisors to accept and expend the Gift as Resolution
