
# Friendly Reminders


- Noe Courts Park is a neighborhood resource.

# Community Opportunity Fund


- \$211K grant award

# Community Feedback


- Fix drainage

- Balance people-only space with dog-friendly space







Noe Courts Site



Douglass Playground	.5 miles	Children's Play Area, Basketball Court, Off-leash Dog Area, Picnic Area, Recreational Facility, Trails, <u>Tennis Court</u>
Eureka Valley Playground	.7 miles	Ball Diamond, Basketball Court, Children's Play Area, Off-leash Dog Area, Recreational Facility, <u>Tennis Court</u>
Christopher Playground	.9 miles	<u>Tennis Court</u> , Community Garden, Softball & Play Structure
Corona Heights Courts	1.2 miles	(2) <u>Tennis Courts</u>

18 votes (46%)





# Community Feedback on the Preferred Option


- Great use of space

- Like walkway around “people zone”

















