

900 Innes U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Brownfield Cleanup Grant Public Meeting and Request for Comments




The San Francisco Recreation and Park Department (SFRPD) has recently acquired the 900 Innes property for future open space. This waterfront land sits between the existing India Basin Shoreline Park and India Basin Shoreline Open Space. Its historic boatbuilding and ship repair uses have resulted in environmental contamination. SFRPD is applying for a U.S. EPA grant to pay for the development and implementation of a plan and site clean-up.

SFRPD is hosting a public meeting to discuss the grant, environmental conditions at 900 Innes, and the conceptual clean-up plan. The public is invited to comment on the grant application until December 16.
