

from Vision Plan, May 2019

Make Post Street visually open and inviting

while mitigating wind and providing seating and shade.

Provide a large permanent stage

and seating to accommodate 200-300 people.

Make Peace Plaza an inviting and playful space

for people of all ages to discover and explore.

Create an inviting visual expression along the Geary Boulevard edge

that draws people into the plaza and mitigates noise levels from Geary Boulevard.

Incorporate significant cultural elements

included in the original design for Japantown Peace Plaza.
