## Message from the Harbor Master

Topic 1

Congratulations to Team Spain for winning Season 4 of SAIL GP! We hope everyone had the opportunity to come and witness the excitement for yourselves. Sail GP will be returning to the Marina in May 2025, with the races occurring on the 22nd and 23rd!

We currently have a few projects underway and pending within the Marina:

- (East Basin) Completion of Gate 10 gangway is scheduled to be completed by the end of August.
- (West Basin) Two sections of the failed jetty seawall have been repaired.
- (West Basin) Continuing repairs on multiple breaks in the water main along the jetty. We will keep tenants apprised if water service will be interrupted.
- (West Basin) West channel dredging bid has been released. Outcomes and dates of upcoming fall dredging episode will be sent via email to all tenants, posted on the Marina website, and included in the next newsletter.

## Key Fobs

In an effort to keep up with the latest advancements and strengthen the Marina's security, we have upgraded the key fob readers at all of our gates. We have also acquired new fobs, as some that have been returned look as if they've been through a woodchipper! Our new key fob series are **00001-00700**.

This means if you have key fobs with a hotstamp in the 03000 series it will be turned off Monday, August 19, 2024, at 12PM PST. Please come and pick up a new fob ASAP.

You must trade an old fob on file to receive a new fob or there will be \$37.00 charge. If this is your first fob it's complimentary!

# BERTHING LICENSE RENEWALS 2024

I know everyone has been wondering when their Berthing License Renewal will be coming in the mail. The answer is soon! We are currently in the process of transitioning to our new marina database DOCKWA. This upgrade will give you the ability to pay berthing fees online, check your account information online, chat with Marina staff via your profile portal and so much more! This is a *HUGE* undertaking, and we are doing our best to complete this task and maintain everyday Marina duties and responsibilities. For this reason, SF Marina Berthing License Renewals for fiscal year 2024 2025 will be sent out August 12, 2024, with a due date of September 31, 2024. We will be reformatting the renewals page, and we ask that everyone fill out their form in its entirety, so that we can verify current contact and berthing information for the new database.

## BERTH RELEASE AND TRANSFERS

### RELEASE OF SLIP

Terminating your berth requires you sign an Intent to Terminate Form and remove your items and lines from your berth and vessel from the Marina. The Intent to Terminate Form must be submitted to the office by the 15th of the month to avoid the responsibility of berthing fees for the following month. You will have 30 days to remove your vessel, clean out your dock box, and remove all lines and accessories at your berth. Once all is removed, the office will assess your account and determine whether there is a balance due, refund to be awarded, or a zero balance.

### BERTH TRANSFER FROM WAIT LIST

This option is only available to slips with berthing licenses that commenced April 2012 and earlier. With this option you must sell your berth with your vessel. This has many steps and a full explanation can be found in the Berth Transfer Pamphlet. Please note that with this option, you will continue to pay your berthing fees while you find a buyer and no refunds are awarded to those terminate via boat sale. See pamphlet on Marina website!

### BERTH TRANSFER VIA PARTNER

Berthing licenses can be transferred to a Registered Marina Partner with only a minimal fee. Two Registered Marina Partners are allowed per berthing license and you can only add a partner within 30 days of bringing in a new boat to the Marina. Please check with the office to see if your boat partner is registered and qualifies for a transfer.
