Greetings all!

We look forward to the Opening Day festivities on April 28th this spring, its always a fun time onboard and on shore.

As many of you will be starting your boating season early, remember we have two pumpout units, (1 west and 1 east) for your boat sewage holding tank needs.

We have placed on our website (link here) showing the most recent Etrac depth sounding for the west marina entry area. So far, we see buildup of sand alongside the jetty but not having too much impact in the main channel area, we anticipate fall west channel dredging with more information in coming months. The east marina boat consolidation went well; however, we anticipate due to permitting activities the initial demolition of the southern east docks will not occur till late summer early fall of 2024.

Thank you all who participated in the boat moving effort and activities, much appreciated.

As many of you know the north face of the jetty between the two yacht clubs has some seawall and sidewalk damages from past storm events. We anticipate the repairs to start soon and be completed in early summer just in time for the SailGP 2024 events. Additional barricades have been installed till the work is completed and for public safety. The some 30 plus sink holes that were around the perimeter of the west harbor have been repaired in the past weeks.

Our next Dock Captain meeting is anticipated to be in early mid-April and notices will be sent out as the date is confirmed. If you would like to join Dock Captains, please email me at scott.grindy@sfgov.org so we can keep you looped in.
