

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Historical Context: Memorial to honor Irish immigrants who arrived in San Francisco during the 1840s and 50s seeking a better life.

Memorial Purpose: The project aims to create a permanent memorial in San Francisco to honor the victims and survivors of the "Great Hunger" that occurred in Ireland from 1845-1852.

Project Phases:

Phase 1: Construction of a concrete plaza in collaboration with the Recreation and Park Department and the Committee.

Phase 2: Installation of artwork on the plaza, managed jointly by the Committee and the San Francisco Arts Commission.








STYLE: RECESSED WALL - DIRECTED LIGHT

STYLE: SYSTEM BOLLARD + UNSHIELDED HEAD WITH SAFETY GUARD




