The damaged included using a battery powered grinder to remove locks, electronic access sensors and more, and repairs are underway to remedy this damage. Please if you see something please report it asap to the Park Rangers or 911.
2. Notices should be coming to your email regarding the dock removal in the southern half of the east harbor which will occur after fleet week.


# Operational Updates

## Proper Trash Disposal
