



## **San Francisco Marina Dock Cart Use Policy**

*A Dock Cart Use Policy is being put in place during the trial period while the Marina determines if the program has merit and the positive aspects outweigh the negative.*

*During the trial period several use procedures will be expected and monitored to determine if the program should be permanent or cease altogether. The following is a list of expectations to aid in this program becoming a permanent fixture:*

- 1 Cart will be placed in the West on the largest docks for a total of 4. Those locations will be at A-Dock (gates 1/3), E-Dock (gate 7), F-Dock (gates 9,11,13) and G-Dock (Gates 17/19).
- Carts will be secured with a cable and combination lock and once the cart has been used, it will be returned to the original location for use by other tenants. Short term use and return for all boaters to have use and access.
- The Combination code will be emailed to berthing tenants and available by calling the marina office during business hours.
- Carts are marked specifically for the docks that they are located on and should remain on those docks and at the specified gate location.
- Carts are not to be left outside of the marina gates or docks from the cart's original location or taken beyond the Marina property.
- Carts are not to be taken on vessels for personal use while out on the water or other.
- Carts are not to be used as coolers.
- Carts are not to transport Hazardous materials, including fuel, oils and lubricants.
- These carts are for Tenant/Marina use only and not to be used for contract work such as divers or their equipment, boat workers or their equipment, mechanics or their equipment, or other, etc.
- Carts are not to be used to haul fish, and hot items that will melt the plastic cart tub.
- Carts are not to be used to transport individuals of any size at any time, this includes transporting or placing children in them
- Carts should be used for short term periods only as they are to be shared amongst tenants
- Carts should be cleaned up after use if there is any kind of spill in them
- Items in the cart should never exceed 350 lbs.
- Boating tenants should notify the Marina Office if a cart is found damaged for repairs.

*During this six-month trial period, if it is determined by the Harbor Master that any of the above rules have been blatantly or purposely ignored, the program will be ended and the carts removed. If, however, the trial period proves successful, more carts may be added in the coming year.*
