In accordance with San Francisco Health Code (SFHC) Article 22A/22B and San Francisco Building Code Section 106.3.2.4, the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Environmental Health Branch, Contaminated Sites Assessment and Mitigation Program (EHB-SAM) has received and reviewed the following documents related to the property located at 401 Hunters Point Boulevard, San Francisco, California (the Site):
