

POINTS OF INTEREST

Perched on the rim of Noe Valley, Billy Goat Hill offers one of the most spectacular views in the City - from downtown to the San Francisco Bay Bridge to the East Bay Hills. A surprising array of native wildflowers and wildlife species still persist on this rocky steep slope, including the California saxifrage, which blooms in early spring, and still clings to the steep slopes above 30th Street. Only in two other areas in San Francisco can this plant be found.

This area boasts the highest diversity of bee species in the city with birds, bees and butterflies venturing to and from this open space to neighboring backyards, carrying seeds and servicing flowers.
