





Street Presence

Active facades along both 6th & Folsom Streets

Massing

Simple, efficient massing at corner of 6th & Folsom

Entry

Main entry along 6th Street

Cafe

1. Located along Folsom Street
2. Cafe is treated like a separate "pavilion"

Gym Location



At 6th & Folsom to create visually active corner

Multi-Purpose Rooms (MPRs)

MPRs on both 1st and 2nd floors

Outdoor Space

1. Playground adjacent to cafe along Harriet
2. 2nd floor terrace facing Harriet


CONCEPTUAL DESIGN **FIRST FLOOR PLAN** [SCHEME 1]
