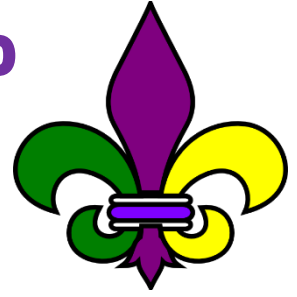




Adult's Senior Get-A-Way to CAMP MATHER

- **Online Lottery Registration begins on Monday, February 26-Saturday, March 3**
Register at: www.sfrecrepark.org/register (log into your existing account)
 - full payment required to register into the camp lottery online or in-person
 - credit cards accepted online and checks only accepted in-person during open office hours stated below at the Golden Gate Park Senior Center
 - a full refund will be returned if not chosen from camp lottery
- **If you prefer to come in-person staff will be available to assist you on Monday, February 26 thru Saturday, March 3 from 10-2PM**

ABOUT SENIOR GET-A-WAY TO CAMP MATHER:

The Senior Get-A-Way to Camp Mather allows those 55 and better, the freedom to travel in the safety and comfort of a bus or having the option to drive up to camp themselves. You will have the chance to take a day trip into Yosemite National Park to enjoy this beautiful natural wonder as well as other excursions within camp.

Relax and play on a four-night nature adventure. You will be staying in a cozy cabin with electricity, beds, dressers, chairs, and a picnic table. Participants bring your own bedding (such as a sleeping bag), towels, etc. The bathrooms and showers are located in well lit bathhouses, a short walk from your cabin. Our meals will be served cafeteria style with a separate fresh salad bar and refreshment bars in our historic dining hall. Staff will provide daily activities such as crafts, hikes, water aerobics as well as fun evening activities such as a movie, talent show, and informative lectures. You are allowed 3 items of luggage (1 carry-on, 1 soft suitcase/duffle/or closable bag, and one sleeping bag) if traveling on a bus. We also give you the option to drive your car up to camp. First time participants are required to attend a pre-camp orientation to learn more details about Camp Mather.

Transportation Options:

- The Golden Gate Park Senior Center (6101 Fulton Street) Pick Up and Drop Off Sites
- The Wawona Clubhouse (20th Avenue and Wawona Street) Pick Up and Drop Off Sites
- Driver and Passenger preferences also available as choices

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

**Non-residents of SF will be automatically placed into the Non-Resident Lottery this year. This means that if you have signed up to room with a SF Resident, you may not be chosen and your SF Resident roommate(s) will be placed with other cabin partners off the SF Resident Lottery list.

*Individuals who do not list a roommate's name will automatically be placed with another independent cabin partner(s) of the same gender. All cabins will be occupied by at least two campers. No exceptions.

*Once you specify your transportation and cabin preferences online, we will not allow any changes to be made, so please take your time and plan ahead.

*The elevation up at Camp Mather is 4,600 feet. August weather can range from dry and hot during the day to cold at night.

*It is necessary to be ambulatory since the terrain can be very uneven and campers will be doing lots of walking.

REFUND POLICY: If you cancel your registration 30 days prior to the session, the withdrawal fee will be 20% (per person). If you cancel your registration less than 30 days prior to the session, there will be NO REFUNDS.

WHEN WILL YOU BE NOTIFIED?

By the end of April, you will receive an email or letter notification to let you know if you "GOT INTO" Camp. (Note: Your letter will be mailed to the home address that you have entered into our online system)
